AS YOU KNOW, SEVERAL SCHOOL BUSES HAD TO BE DIVERTED TODAY. HOWEVER, THE INFORMATION THAT I HAVE RECEIVED FROM OUR FIRST STUDENT BUS COMPANY IS THAT ALL ELEMENTARY CHILDREN WERE ABLE TO BE PICKED UP AND BROUGHT BACK HOME SAFELY. THE SAME WILL BE TRUE TOMORROW.

THE ONLY STOP THAT IS NOT ABLE TO BE ACCOMMODATED FOR TOMORROW, TUESDAY, APRIL 11, 2017, IS FOR MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AT MARLBORO STREET.

COOPERATIVE MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS WHO USUALLY ACCESS THE BUS AT MARLBORO STREET SHOULD GO TO LAS OLAS.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS SHOULD GO TO AUBURN STREET.

I AM SORRY FOR THIS INCONVENIENCE AND DISRUPTION TO THE SCHEDULE BUT I DO HOPE THAT THE MATTER WILL BE RESOLVED BY THE END OF THE DAY ON TUESDAY.
